

How can you get a Disability Certificate?

A Disability Certificate is a government certification of the nature and extent of the disability that a person has. It is the basic document that any Indian with any disability of more than 40% requires in order to avail government facilities, benefits, entitlements and concessions.

Note that under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, a Disability Certificate is NOT required for admission to school.

Who is authorised to issue a Disability Certificate?

State/ District Government Hospitals have Medical Boards which are the certifying authority to issue a Disability Certificate.

The Medical Board consists of:

- Chief Medical Officer/ Sub-Divisional Medical Officer in the district
- An expert in the specified field such as Psychiatrist/ or Clinical Psychologist in case of intellectual disabilities; an Ophthalmologist in case of visual handicaps; ENT specialist/ Audiologist in case of speech and hearing handicaps; Orthopaedician/ or Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation specialist in case of locomotor handicaps.

What are the steps for obtaining a Disability Certificate?

- Step 1.** Obtain a Medical Certificate from a qualified specialist who is an expert in the specified field. To the extent possible, this should be a government doctor, however, the new Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 specifies that medical certification from a qualified private medical specialist would also be considered by the Medical Board.
- Step 2.** Identify an authorized hospital in your district/ state.

- Step 3.** Fill out the application form for the Disability Certificate.

- Step 4.** Attach the Medical Certificate and supporting Documents.
- Step 5.** The parent of a person with disability, or the person her/ himself, should submit the Application Form and supporting documents to the nearest State/ District Government Hospital with her/ his request for obtaining a Disability Certificate.

The following supporting documents are to be provided:

- Recent passport size photographs: 4
- Full-size (head-to-toe) photographs: 2
- Copy of proof of residence attested by a gazetted office.

Attention!

- The Disability Certificate has lifelong validity for persons above the age of 18 years.
What is required as Proof of Age? [Click here.](#)
- For persons less than 18 years, update the Disability Certificate once in every 5 years.

Note that in the case of permanent disability, no fresh medical examination is required for certification.
